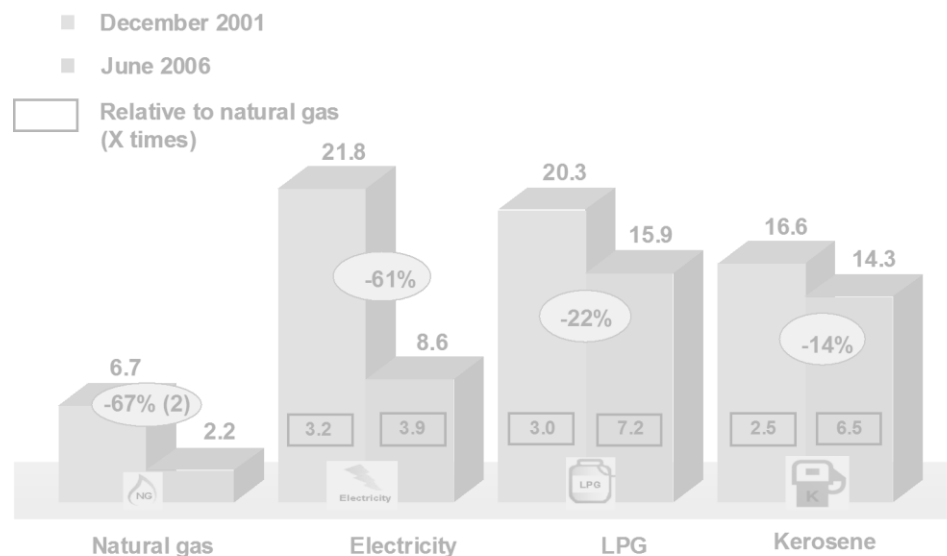
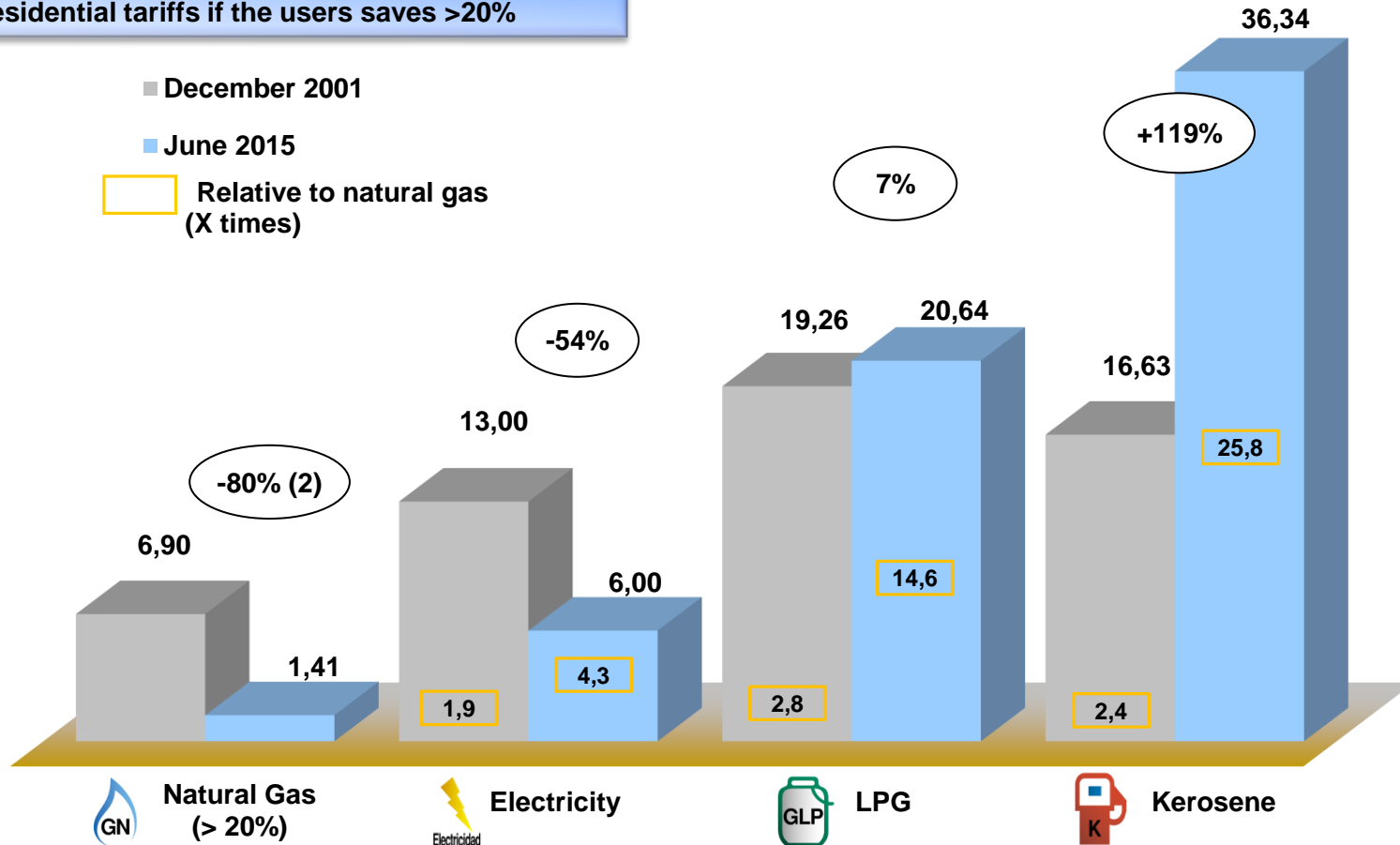


NATURAL GAS PRICES COMPARED TO LIQUID FUELS AND ELECTRIC ENERGY

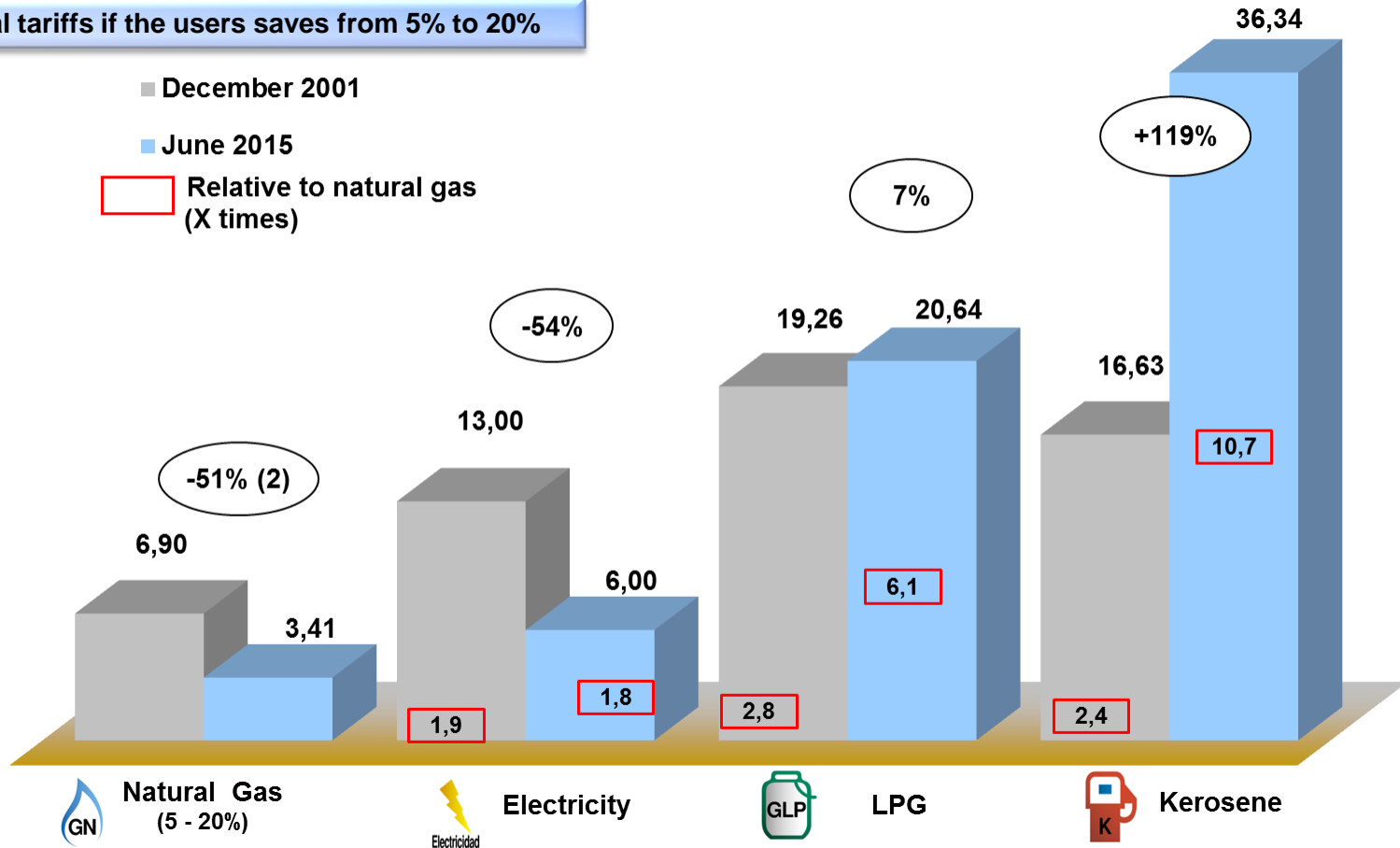

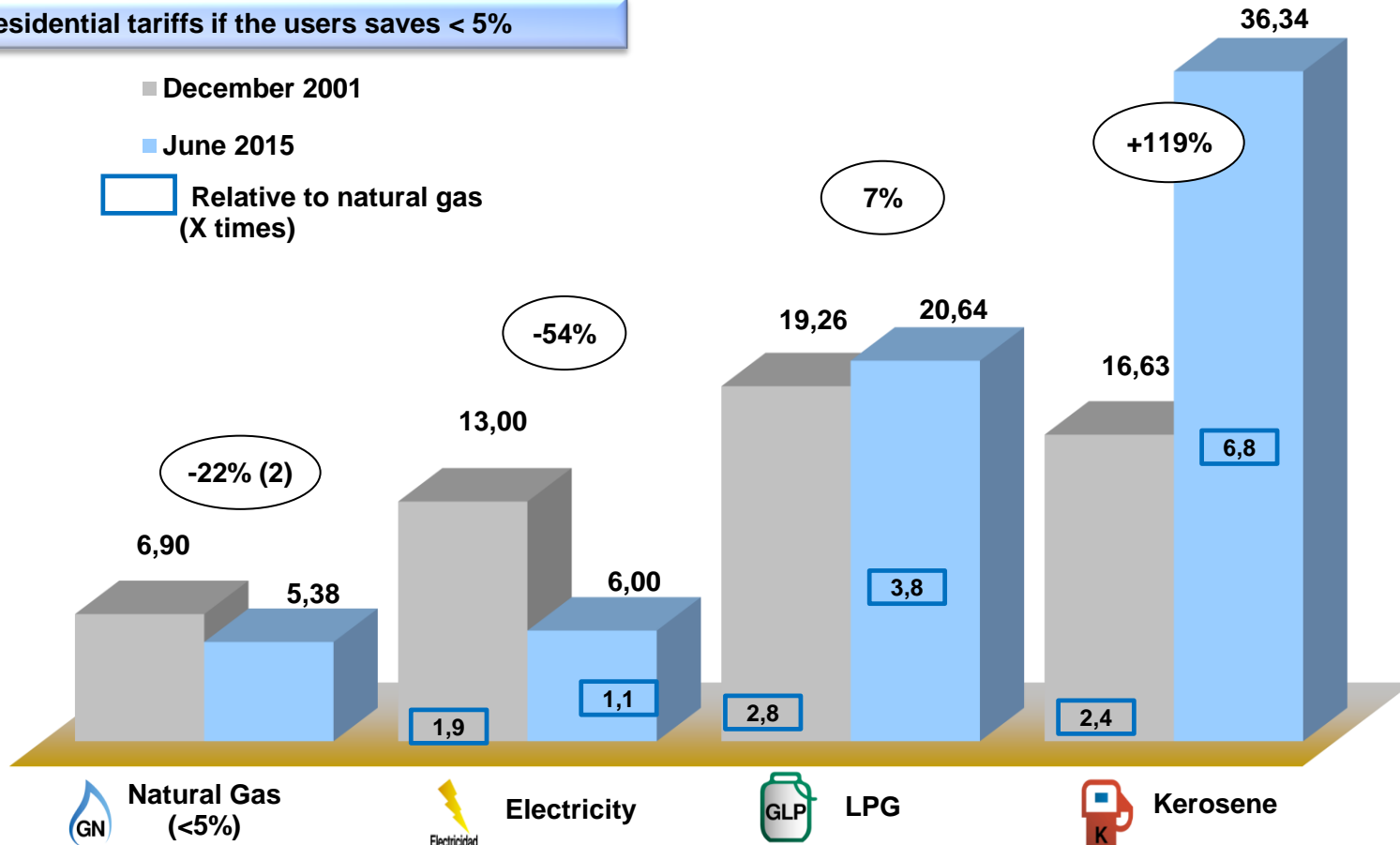

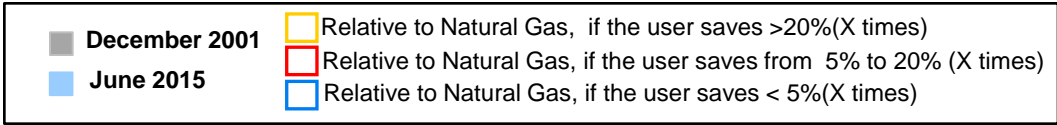

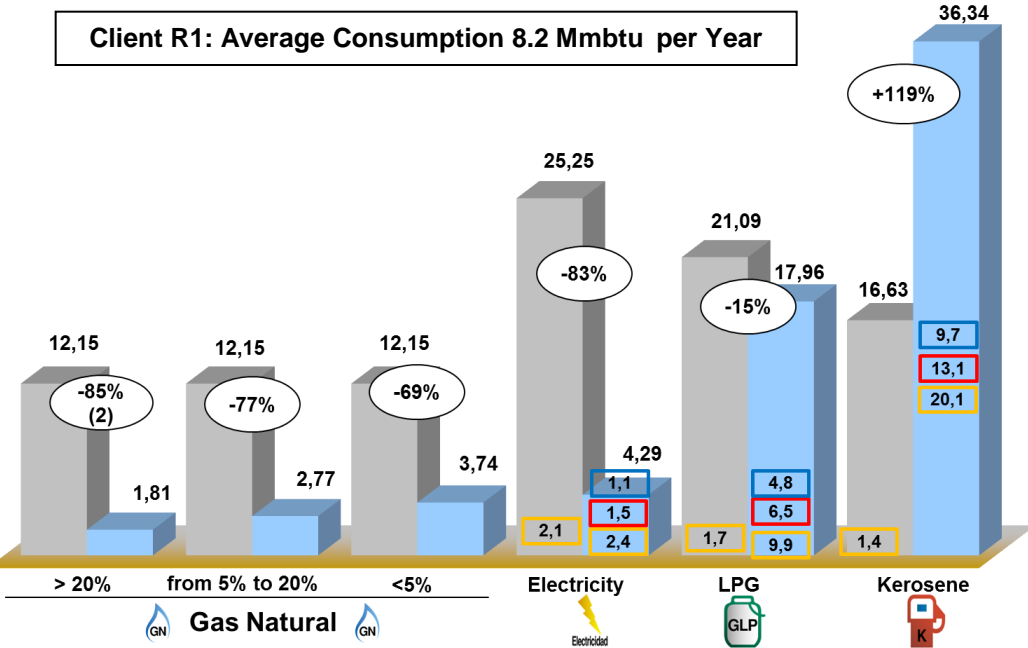

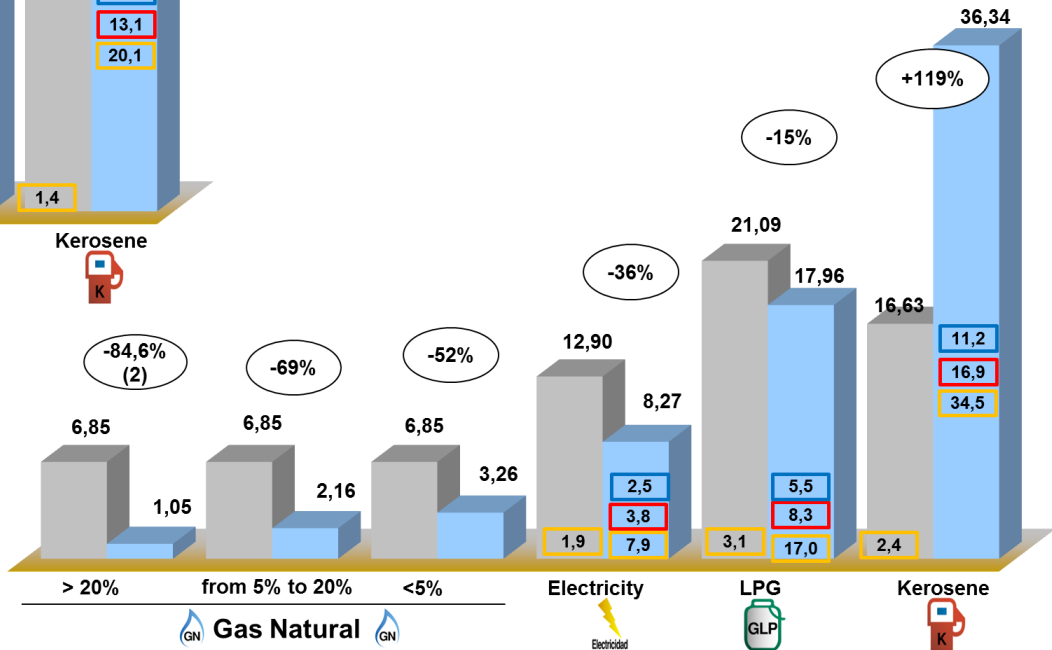

Client R1: Average Consumption 8.2 Mmbtu per Year

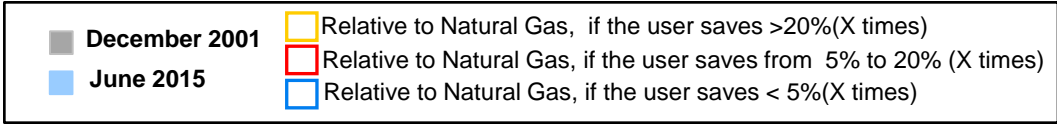


Client R23: Average Consumption 33.1 Mmbtu per Year

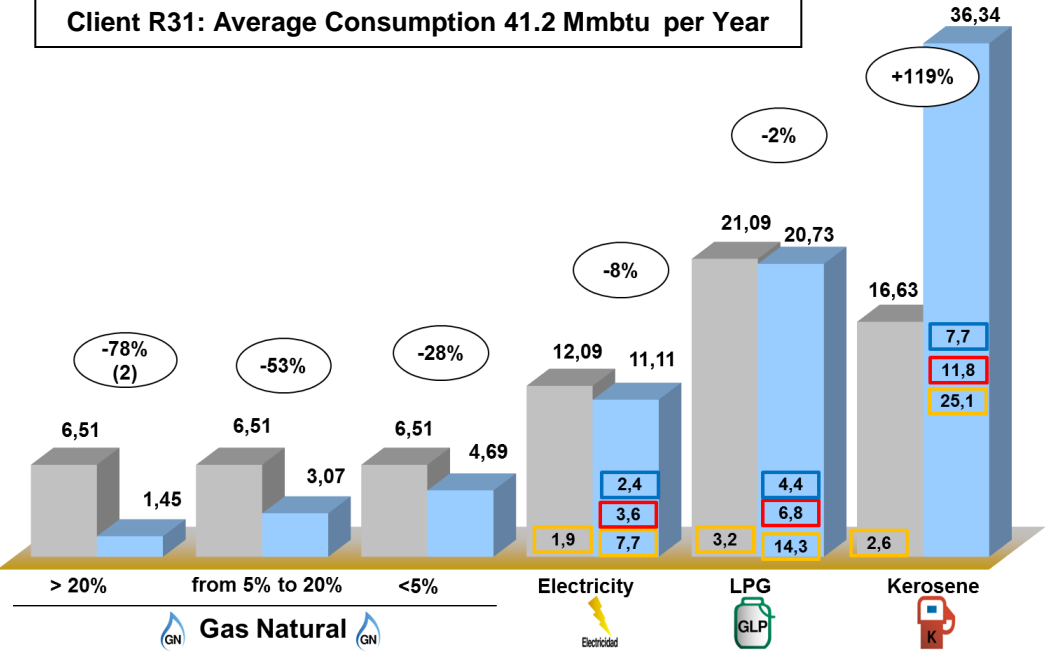

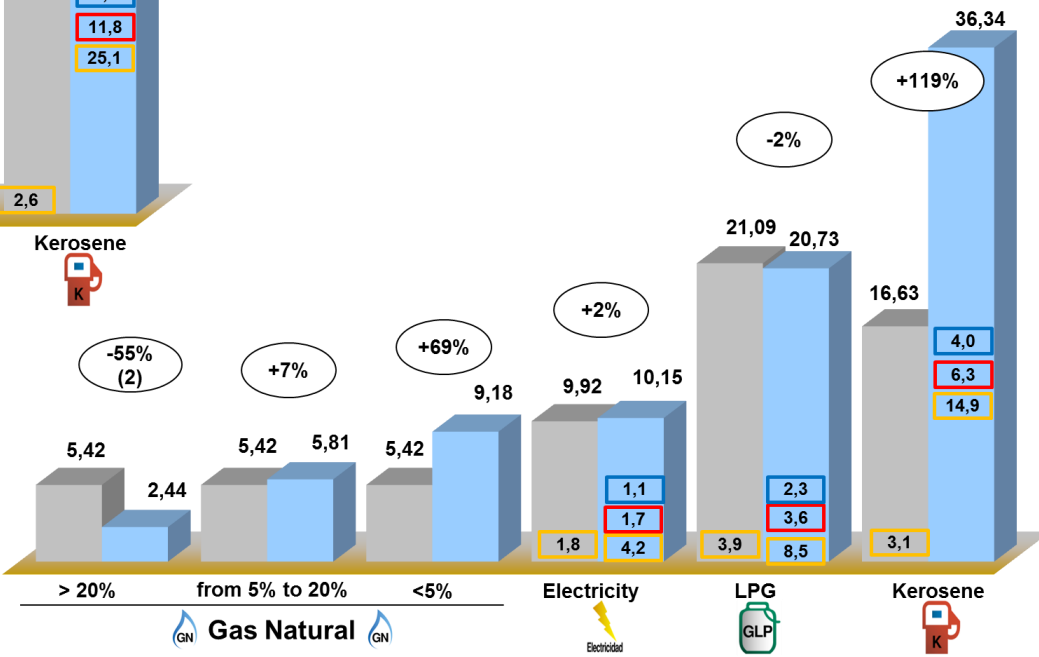

Client R31: Average Consumption 41.2 Mmbtu per Year



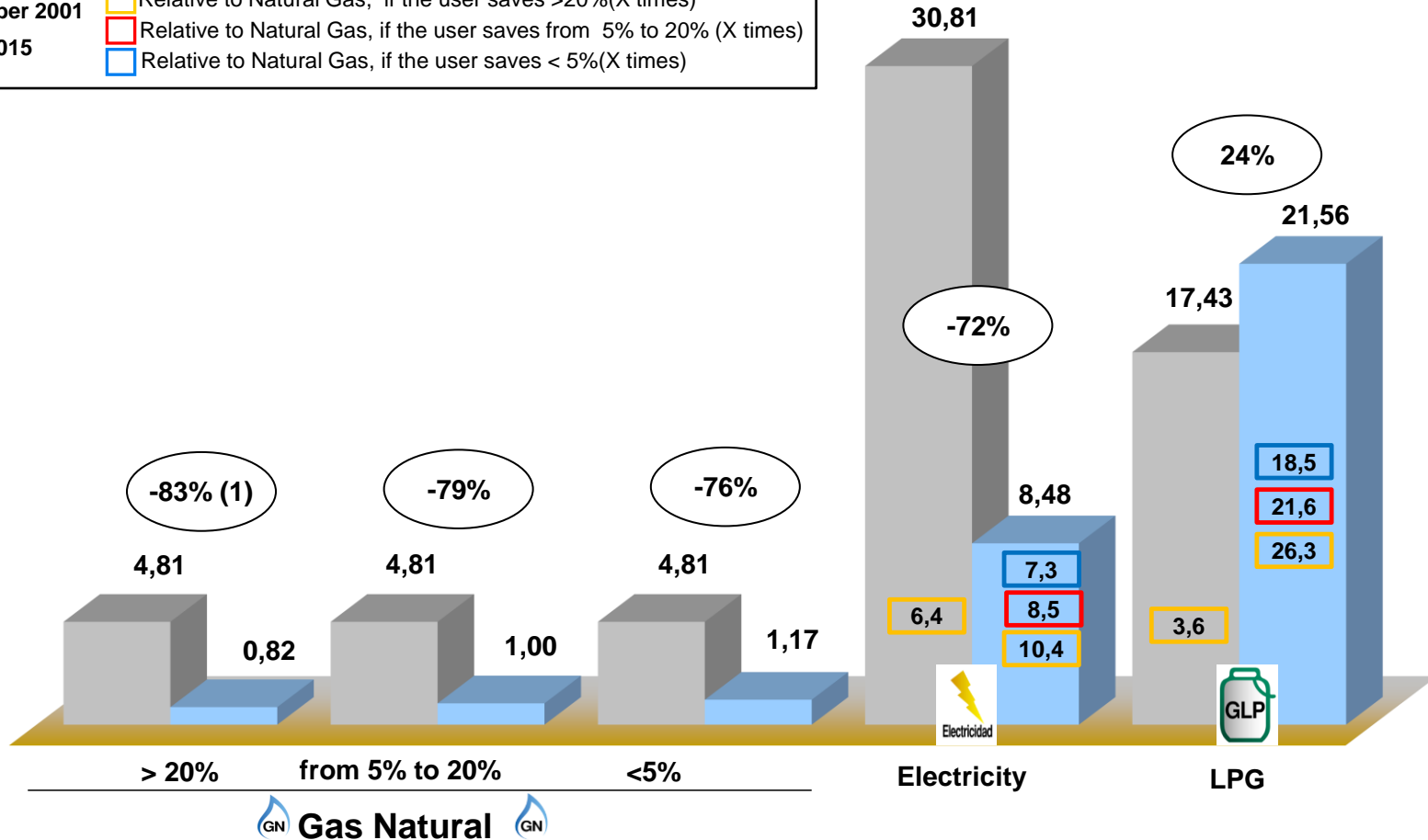

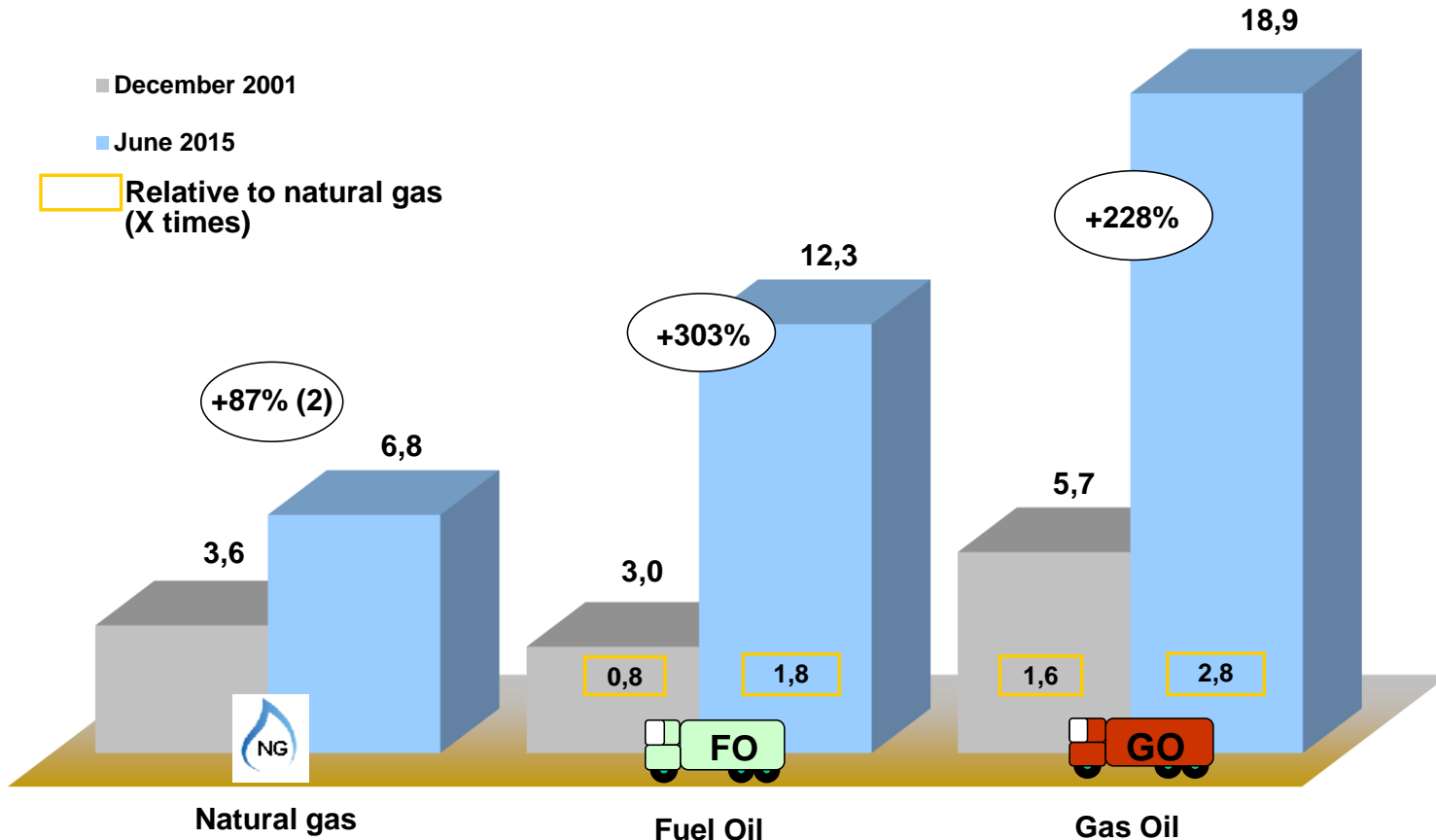

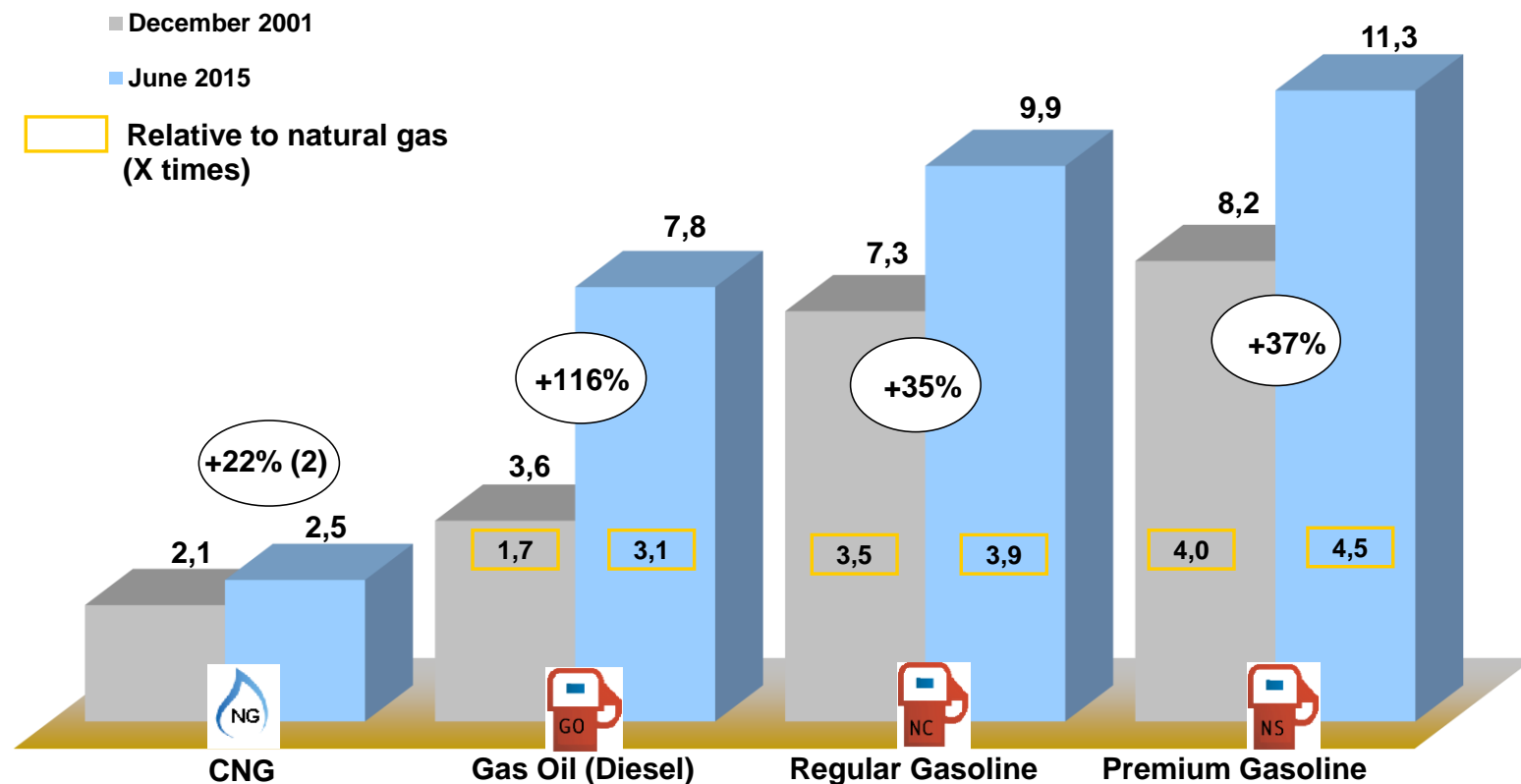

(US\$/100 km)



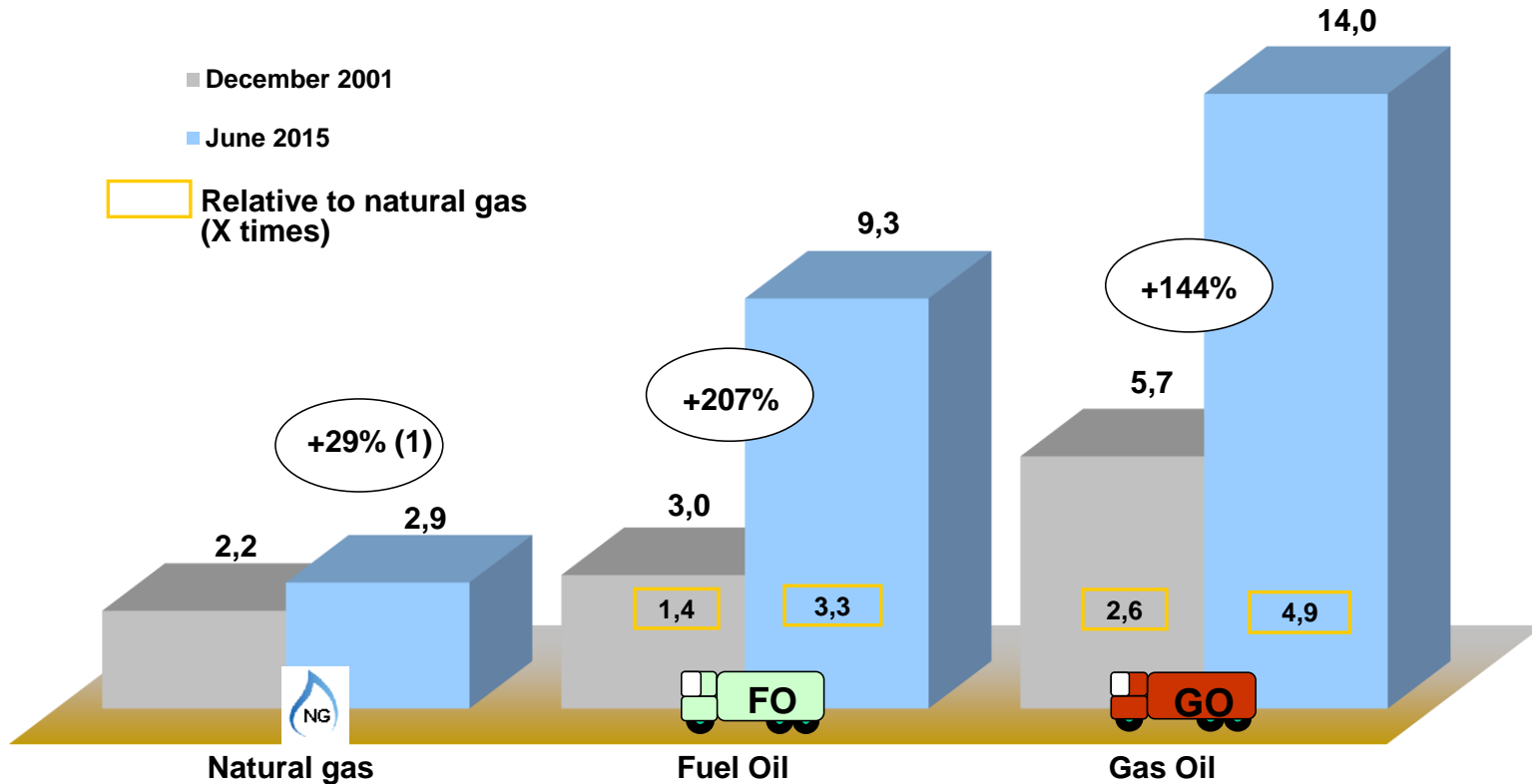
